CURRENT READING

CONSTITUTION ARTICLE IV OFFICERS

SECTION 1: Johnson County Professional Firefighters shall have nominations this one (1) time only in January of 2009 and an election in January of 2009 to elect the new Executive Committee consisting of the President of JCPFF, Secretary/Treasurer of JCPFF, At-Large Trustee of JCPFF, District Vice-Presidents, and District Trustees. Initially, the President and District Trustees will be elected to a two (2) year term. The District Vice-Presidents, Secretary/Treasurer, and At-Large Trustee will be elected to a one (1) year term. This is to offset the elected positions when JCPFF consolidates. The President will then be elected on odd years, the Secretary/Treasurer and At-Large Trustee being elected on even years. This Section will be void February 1st, 2009 and will be taken out of the Constitution and By-Laws.

SECTION 1A: The elected officers of this Local shall consist of a President, Secretary/Treasurer, and one (1) At-Large Trustee, as well as a District Vice-President and Trustee for each District of the Local. The term of office for all officers shall be two years. The Secretary/Treasurer and At-Large Trustees shall be elected in even years. The President shall be elected in odd years. The District Vice-Presidents will be elected in even years and the Trustees in odd years. All newly elected officers shall take office at the first regular meeting in January after their election in December.

SECTION 8: Before the election the President shall appoint an Election Board consisting of Three (3) members, with no less than two (2) Districts represented. The Election Board shall be chaired by the President or the Secretary/Treasurer, which ever is not up for re-election. The Election Board shall determine the method of implementing the election in a manner which safeguards the integrity of said election. The Election Board shall present its' plan to the Executive Board for approval no later than the October Executive Board meeting. No member of the Election Board shall be a candidate while serving on the Election Board.

The Election Board shall be responsible for distributing and tabulating the ballots and shall have such functions as are provided in Article XIII, Section 11 of the International Association of Fire Fighters' Constitution and By-Laws. Each candidate for office shall be entitled to appoint one (1) observer who shall be permitted to witness the manner of distribution and casting of ballots and attend the meeting of the Election Board at which the ballots are tabulated.
